

More information for parents and caregivers

Election timeline

The timeline is available at your school office *and/or* from your returning officer. It may also be published in your school newsletter or on the school website or Facebook page.

Electoral Roll

The voting roll is held at the school office and can be viewed during normal school hours. It is also available in electronic form.

You must advise the returning officer in writing if your name is not present or if you wish to be removed from the roll.

Nominations are online

A hard copy nomination form is also available on request from the school office or your returning officer.

Nominations close at noon on the day specified in your Call for Nominations notice.

You MUST complete your nomination by this time, or you will be locked out of the form.

You may nominate yourself

If you are on the electoral roll, you can nominate yourself. If you are not on the electoral roll, you must be nominated by someone who is.

Candidate Statement

Make sure your statement and photo are received by the nomination deadline so that it can be included on the voting platform.

The returning officer may remove or edit any part of the candidate's statement if it exceeds 400 words or is offensive or defamatory.

Your candidate statement and photo will appear on the online voting platform. If you do not submit a photo, your name will be accompanied by a blank outline.

Voting method

You will be advised by email from the returning officer whether this will be a postal ballot or an electronic election.

Electronic voting requires the provider to be accredited. If electronic voting is permitted, you will be emailed a link at your email address to the Voting Platform. You will need your mobile phone to authenticate yourself.

If this is a postal ballot, you will be mailed voting papers at the address the school has for you. If you have changed address, you should advise the school immediately.

Voting will close at **4pm** on the date specified in your invitation to vote.

Scrutineers

A candidate may nominate a person to check the vote count to make sure it is done correctly. Please advise the returning officer in writing of your scrutineer's name and contact details before election day. Candidates cannot be scrutineers.

Ka taea e koe te whakaingoa i a koe ano.

Mēnā kei runga koe i te rārangi pōti, ka taea e koe te whakaingoa i a koe ano.

Mēnā karekau koe i te rārangi pōti, me whakaingoa koe e tetahi tangata.

Kōrero kaitono

Mēnā he kaitono koe, kei a koe te tikanga ki te tuku i tētahi tauākī (atu ki te 400 kupu), ā, me tētahi whakaahua.

Tērā pea ka whakakorea, ka whakapotoa rānei e te āpiha whakahoki pōti he wāhanga o te tauākī a te kaitono mēnā ka nui atu i te 400 kupu, he weriweri, he whakatūtara rānei.

Ka puta to rārangi pōti me to whakaahua ki runga ipurangi te pōti.

Kei te ipurangi te pōti

Ka tukuna atu e matou he hononga imēra ki a koe ki te papa pōti.

Motuhēhē koe mā te whakamahi i tō waea pūkoro.

Ka kati te pōti hei te **4pm** ki te rā kati (tirohia te karanga ki te pōti)

Ngā Kaitirotiro

Ka tōhua pea e te kaitono tētahi tangata ki te tirotiro i te tātau pōti kia mōhio kei te tika te mahi. Tēnā whakamōhio te āpiha kaiwhakahoki mā te tuhi reta, ke te ingoa o tō kaitirotiro me ōna taipitopito whakapā i mua o te rā pōti. E kore e āhei ngā kaitono ke te tū hei kaitirotiro.
